### Recommendation of the Joint Nordic Student ID Card (ISIC)

The Danish National Commission for UNESCO continues to support the joint Nordic Student ID Card (ISIC). The purpose of the ISIC Student ID Card is to help students take advantage of offers on travel, shopping, museums etc. worldwide. Any full time student attending medium cycle and long cycle higher education is eligible for an ISIC card.

The ISIC may help increase mobility among students - Danish as well as students from the other Nordic countries.

Throughout the years UNESCO has supported similar activities and wishes to promote the mutual recognition of qualifications giving access to higher education, periods of study and higher education qualifications as laid down in the Lisbon Recognition Convention (1997).
